

# PRODUCT DATA

#### **Description:**

Most commonly used french polish for use on dark woods, or where light woods need to be slightly coloured. Can be mixed with transparent or white polish to provide a hint of colour.

#### Area of use:

Interior and exterior.

#### Substrates:

Wood

## **Physical Constants:**

Colour:	Brown
Finish:	Gloss
Volume solids:	25%
Theoretical spreading rate: Flash point:	18 sq. metres per litre 38°C
Specific gravity:	0.85
Dry to touch:	5 – 10 minutes (20°C)
Overcoating time:	15 – 20 minutes

\*The theoretical spreading rate has been calculated for the stated volume solids and dry film thickness. A practical spreading rate will depend on the actual dry film thickness, the nature of the substrate, and the relevant consumption factor. The physical constants are subject to normal manufacturing tolerances.

### **Application Details:**

Application method:	Cloth or Fad
Thinner:	Methylated Spirit
Cleaning of tools:	Methylated Spirit
Surface condition:	The surface should be stable, firm, dry and free of dust, sand, loose old paint, dirt, grease and oil. Use a shellac sanding sealer to give a smooth surface prior to using brown french polish.
